We are a family-owned Certified Organic farm in Baileys Harbor, WI, raising Black Angus cattle, Berkshire pigs, poultry (broilers and egg-layers) and we have a 2-acre seasonal garden. We currently have 1,000 acres under management and are continuing to expand. Our farm has the first small scale Temple Grandin designed handling system ever built.

We have a store on the farm, where we sell our products, as well as, other locally produced products. We also have a second store in De Pere, and we sell at restaurants and farm markets throughout Door and Brown County.

- Willingness to learn all aspects of a diversified family farm and work as a member of a team.

- Ability to lift 50lbs consistently and 80lbs occasionally.
- Comfortable with animals.
- You must have a valid driver's license and be a safe driver capable of driving a pick-up truck and stock trailer/goose neck trailer. You may also be asked to pick up or deliver product in a delivery van.
