



Waseda Farms

History

This land was organically farmed by the *Priests of the Sacred Heart* for 50 years prior to the Lutseys & the Waseda Farms family accepting responsibility. Look for reminders of this past as you walk amidst grottoes, crosses, and benches, and among the old fields named for the previous priests and stewards.

The Name

Waseda Farms was the name given to the farm by the O'Brien family, who deeded the land to the Priests. The name is thought to have come from an old native Pottawatomi word describing the way the wind blows through the tall pine trees.

The Land

- We are the stewards of 1400 acres of this beautiful green earth. We farm 900 acres of our neighbors' lands in order to grow hay for our cattle through the Wisconsin winter and grain for our pigs and chickens.
- The farm sits atop 420 million year old dolomitic limestone; look in the ancient rock fences for coral fossils and non-native boulders left by previous glacial movements through the land

The Animals

We are the caretakers of the following animals

- 600 head of cattle (Black Angus & Hereford)
- 150 hogs (Berkshire)
- 2400 egg-laying hens (3 different breeds/colors)

Sustainable farming

- We are "Certified Organic," meaning:
 - no genetically modified seeds
 - no artificial fertilizers or pesticides
 - no hormones / anti-biotics
 - space for our animals to live & roam freely
- We are committed to treating our animals with respect and giving them the best possible lives
- We are committed to living in harmony with our animals, land, water & environment, and we aim to make our earth better each year

Please be aware that you travel on our working farm at your own risk. There are stones, holes, bumps, and wild animals, including mamma cows, bulls and bees all around!

- Let a team member at the store know you are walking
